1. Dr. Madhavrao Chitale (Chairman from 2006 to 2009)



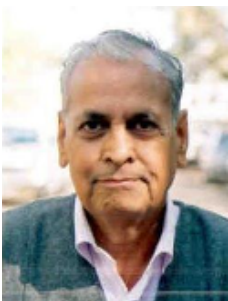
