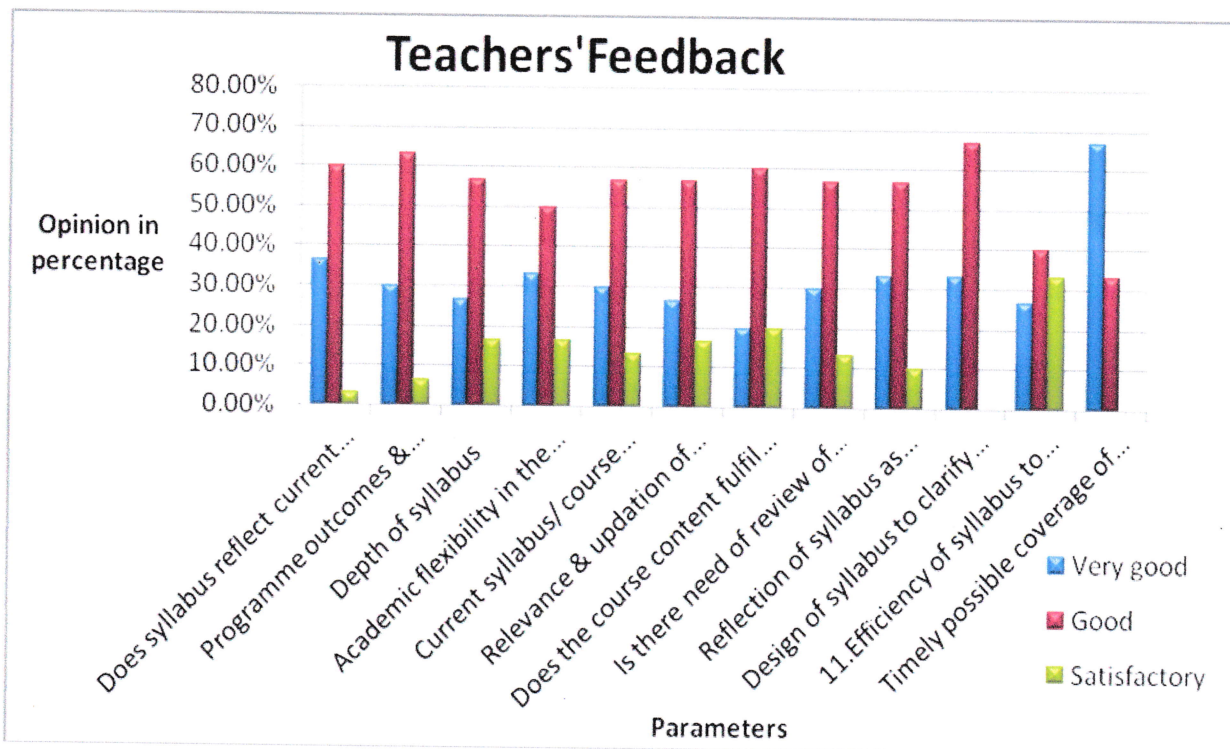

General Comments:

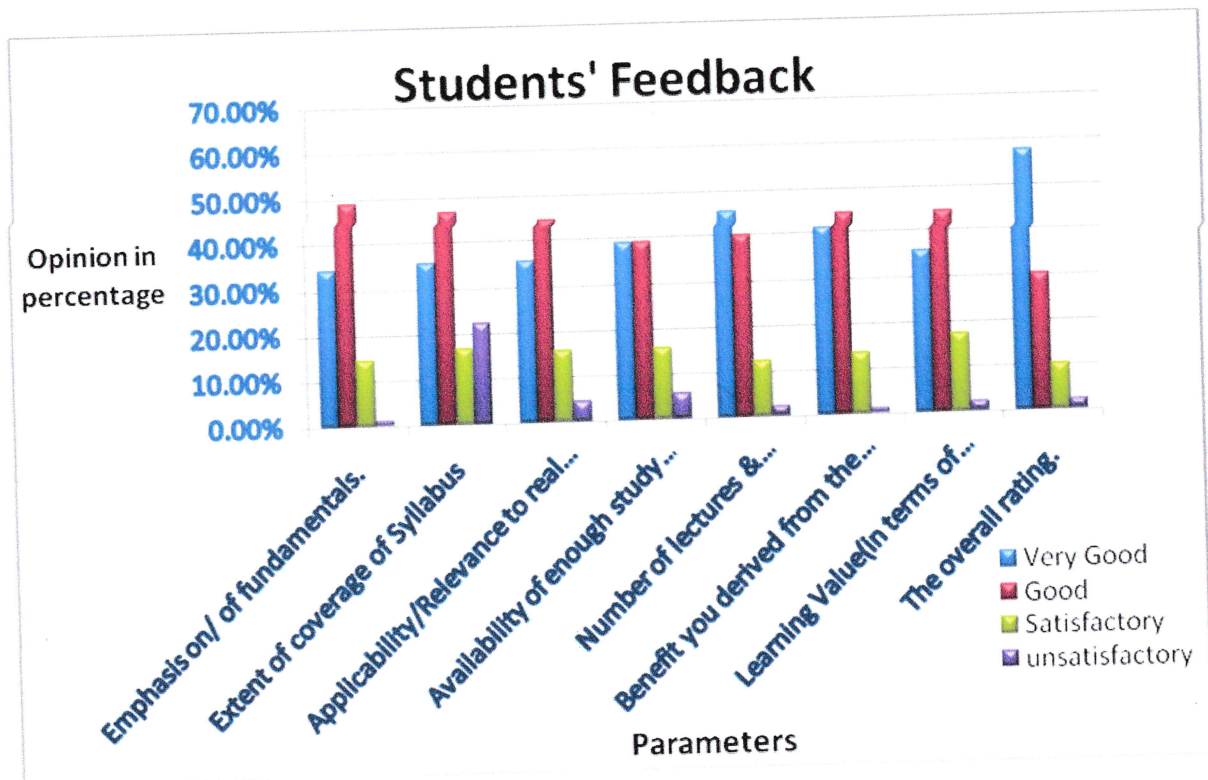
1. The feedback of the teachers about the curriculum is good.

General Comments:

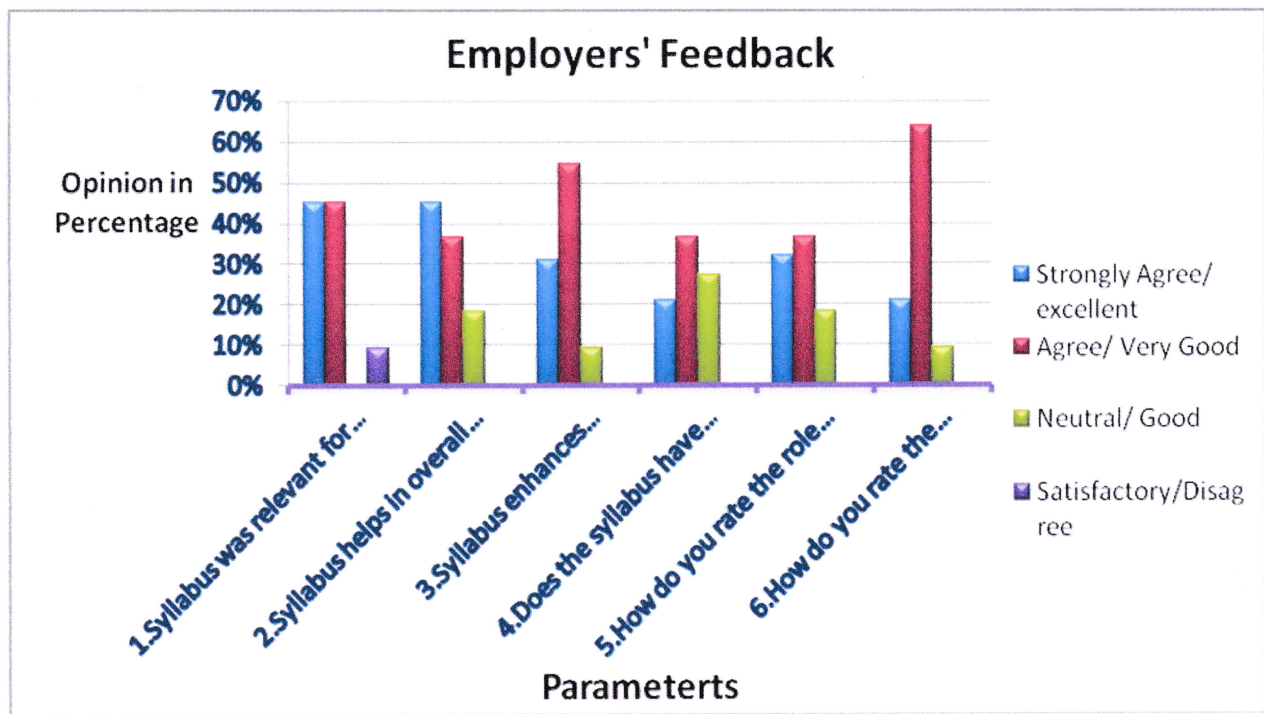
- Most of the students are satisfied with the fundamentals, coverage of the course, practical life relevance.

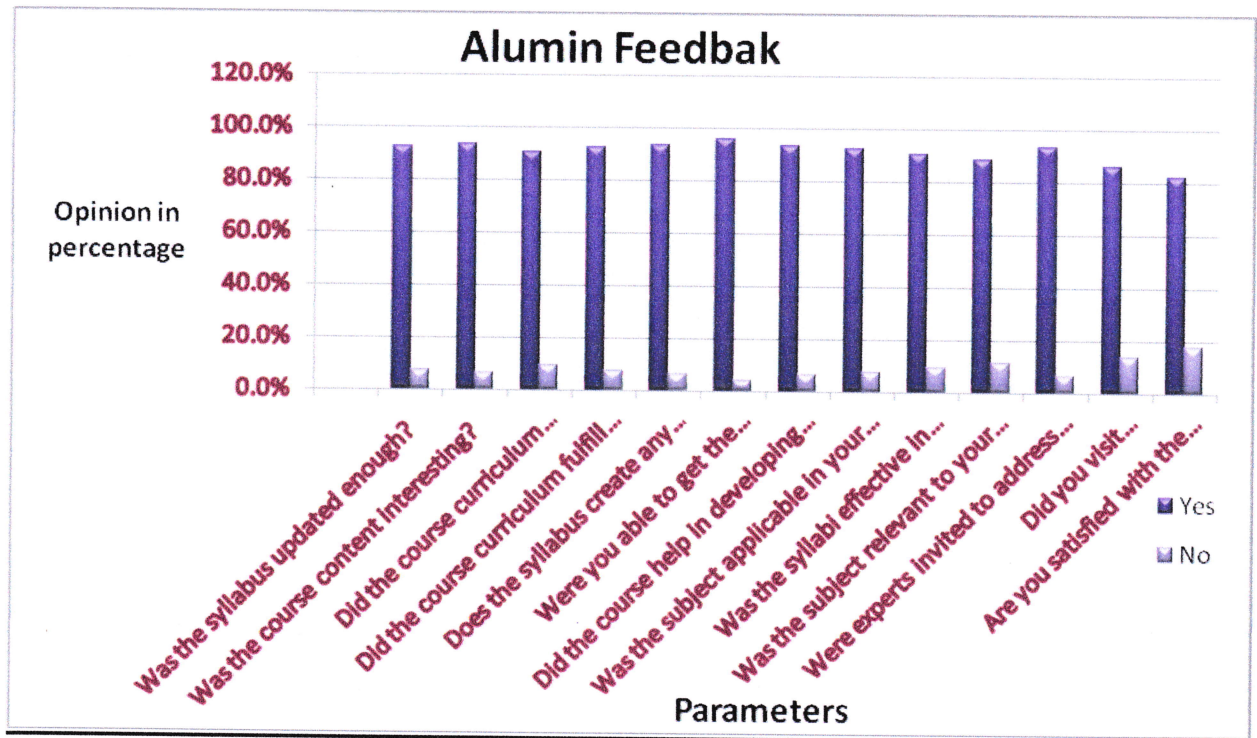
- a) The overall feedback of the employers about the institution and the curriculum is very good and positive.

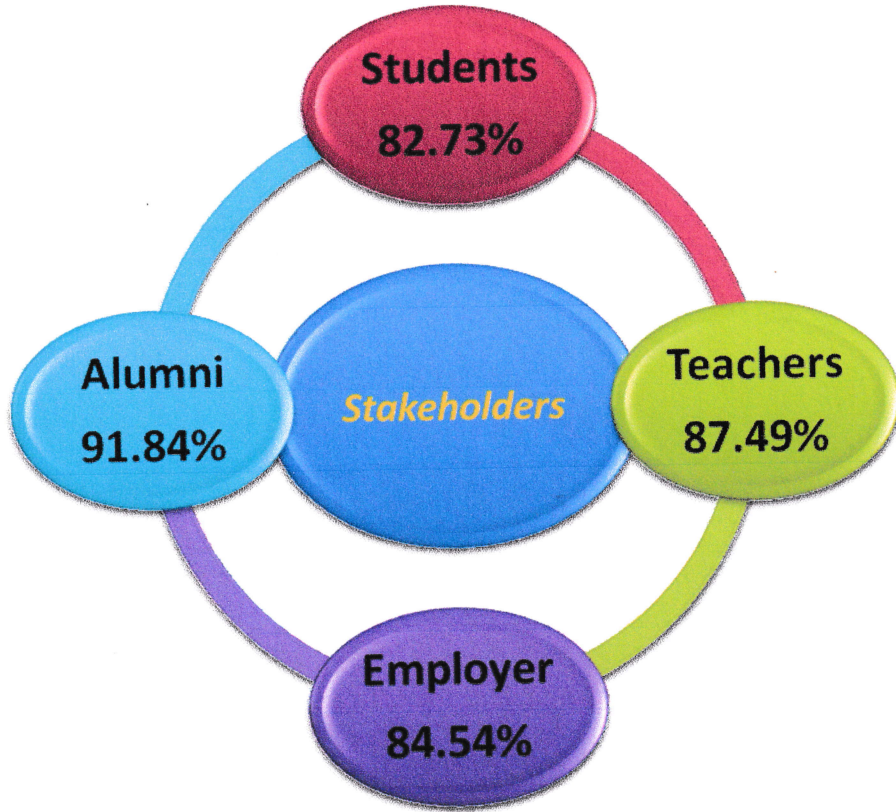


General Comments
